15% Allocation Reimbursement Requests – An updated report of the ETSB Carryover Allocation Fund was presented reflecting no new requests for reimbursement, leaving a remaining balance of \$322,666.80. No new consolidation expense reimbursement requests were received leaving a remaining balance of \$2,400,000.00.

Motion by Robert McGowen and seconded by TJ Fowler to approve the financial report and expenses as reviewed. Motion carried unanimously.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

GIS Data Aggregation for NG911 Service – Jonathan Duran updated the board on GIS work being done. No new changes on the report but county data improvements continue. An MSAG was created and implemented for Calhoun County who has been a wireless only 911 county. City of Dermott weighing options regarding readdressing.

**ESInet & NextGen Core Services** – C.J. Engel shared that one PSAP has been transitioned since the previous meeting. 81 PSAPs and 5 Dispatch Centers are currently connected to the statewide ESInet. Of these, 54 are i3, 30 are RFAI and 2 CAMA with a population of 2,716,265 or 90.94% covered and reflecting a combined local savings of \$1,439,074.08 annually to PSAPs.

# **PSAP Consolidation Updates**

Clark County – Guests on the Zoom included Clark County Judge Troy Tucker, Sheriff Jason Watson, Arkadelphia City Manager Gary Brinkley, Arkadelphia Police Chief Jason Jackson. Judge Tucker updated the Board on Clark County and Arkadelphia's PSAP consolidation process including the identification and remodeling of a facility. The group is working on intergovernmental agreements following recent visits with other counties.

**Annual Legislative Report** – The annual legislative report required by state statute to was provided to the Board for review by Mr. Engel. Expect that this will be on the ALC agenda soon.
