Motion by Robert McGowen and seconded by TJ Fowler to approve the Minutes from the August 29, 2024 Arkansas 911 Board Meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

Financial Report – C.J. Engel provided the financial report reflecting the total assets and liabilities as of August 31, 2024, to be \$25,622,301.96 in which \$12,567,109.31 is in the State Treasury and \$13,045,876.47 is with U.S. Bank.

Expenses – Expenses for month ending August 31, 2024 totaling \$504,563.07 included:

2Q24 PSAP Quarterly Distribution - \$9,919,501.70 will be distributed in September.

15% Allocation Reimbursement Requests – An updated report of the ETSB Carryover Allocation Fund was presented reflecting no new requests for reimbursement, leaving a remaining balance of \$322,666.80. No new consolidation expense reimbursement requests were received leaving a remaining balance of \$6,200,000.00.

Motion by TJ Fowler and seconded by Robert McGowen to approve the financial report and expenses as reviewed. Motion carried unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

GIS Data Aggregation for NG911 Service – Shelby Johnson updated the Board on the Arkansas GIS Office's most recent project activities including the completion of the Pulaski County and City of Jacksonville data conversion due to consolidation.

ESInet & NextGen Core Services – C.J. Engel shared that 86 PSAPs and 5 Dispatch Centers are now connected to the statewide ESInet. With these transitions, a total population of 2,851,116 is covered or 95.46% of the state's population.

No new business was brought before the Board.

A.J. Gary opened the floor to questions/comments from the board and/or guests.

C.J. Engel discussed the Pulaski County and City of Jacksonville consolidation efforts, and go live on September 18, 2024. Reminder letters were also sent out to entities lining out deadlines for consolidation and extension requests.
